

Eagle One Retrofit Antenna Mount

I have owned one of the Eagle One antennas for a couple years now and used it on many remote events such as field day and it is a great antenna for field operations or as a permanent scenario. One part of the system that has always been a bulky piece of hardware to haul around and setup is the tripod.

The bracket clamps can get out of alignment with each other and various other little annoying issues. I now have a great solution in place that is much better, cleaner, and enhances functionality significantly. The TN07 Engineering mounting plate for the Eagle. It mounts handsomely flat on the ground and is a great looking piece of hardware.

The four stakes that drive into the ground on all four corners will keep it from trying to blow over even in strong winds as the tripod always does. It provides a great ground path and with the mounting plate solution comes a blitz bug which now gives me some surge protection from any nearby lightening discharges. Converting to the TN07 mounting plate is very simple and makes for a much better product. My tripod is now sitting over in a corner of the shack and I have no need to load and carry it around. The mounting plate solution looks so much better and bottom line is the antenna system is much more portable now. I highly recommend the mounting plate conversion for anyone who wants to enjoy using the Eagle One with less hassle during setup and more up time for transmitting.
